Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University "2025 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships" for international students Under "The 60th Year Supreme Reign of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej Scholarship" Academic Year 2025

.....

1. Rationales

Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, in collaboration with the graduate programs of Mahidol University, acknowledges the importance of opportunities for deserving students to pursue their education at graduate levels. The "2025 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships" has been initiated to offer international students for scholarships which cover tuition fees and other expenses while studying in the graduate programs of Mahidol University. Those students who have satisfactory academic records and are in need of financial support shall have a chance to study at Mahidol University. This scholarship has been initiated in accordance to Mahidol University's Social Development Goal 4 (SDGs 4: Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all. In additions this scholarship also aims to increase the number of scholars and researchers in various disciplines as well as will create the relations and ties between Mahidol University and grantees' countries of origin.

2. Objectives

- 2.1 To promote and support international students with excellent academic records in pursuing their study for master's and doctoral degrees at Mahidol University
- 2.2 To support the University policy on increasing the number of highly qualified master's and doctoral international students in various fields of study

3. Eligibility Criteria for Scholarship Applicants

3.1 Applicants must be international students eligible for enrollment in a master's or doctoral degree program in the academic year 2025 in any faculty or program, except for the following:

- Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital
- Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital
- Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies
- Faculty of Tropical Medicine
- Faculty of Information and Communication Technology
- International College
- College of Music
- College of Management
- Any joint program where the Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital or the Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital is listed as the primary faculty

3.2 Applicants for **master's program** must obtained a **Bachelor's degree** with following details;

3.3 Applicants for the **Doctoral program** who have completed a **Master's degree** must meet the following eligibility criteria:

3.4 Applicants for the **Doctoral programs** who have completed a **Bachelor's** degree must meet the following eligibility criteria:

Remark: In the case where a scholarship applicant has not yet fully completed their degree and submits their first-semester academic results of the academic year in which they are expected to graduate for scholarship consideration, they must submit their official final academic transcript to the Admission Section, The Faculty of Graduate Studies before the start of the academic term once they have fully completed their degree. If the final academic results do not meet the requirements stated in the scholarship announcement, the Graduate School reserves the right to revoke the scholarship, and the recipient will be required to repay the awarded scholarship amount.

4. Scholarship Types and contribution

4.1 Program Quota Type allocates scholarships specifically for covering fixed-rate tuition fees. The Faculty of Graduate Studies provides support for master's degree students at fixed-rate tuition fees not exceeding 20,000 baht per semester, and for Doctoral degree students at fixed-rate tuition fees not exceeding 25,000 baht per semester. This does not include summer semester fees. If the scholarship recipient registers for the summer semester, they will be responsible for the fees.

4.2 The Central Quota Type allocates scholarships specifically for covering fixed-rate tuition fees. The Graduate School provides support for master's degree students at fixed-rate tuition fees not exceeding 20,000 baht per semester, and for Doctoral degree students at fixed-rate tuition fees not exceeding 25,000 baht per semester and the living allowance 10,000 bath/month. This does not include summer semester fees. If the scholarship recipient registers for the summer semester, they will be responsible for the fees.

4.3 Scholarship Duration

- up to 3 academic years for a student pursuing Doctoral degree. (6 semester)
- up to 2 academic years for a student pursuing Master's degree. (4 semester)

4.4 If the scholarship recipient's thesis examination results are marked as 'Pass' before the end of the scholarship period, it will be considered as the completion of the scholarship within the specified scholarship period as outlined in Clause 4.

5. Disbursement Method

5.1 The Faculty of Graduate Studies provides fixed-rate tuition fees up to 20,000 THB per semester for master's degree students and up to 25,000 THB per semester for doctoral students. Any excess tuition fees beyond the subsidized amount will be deducted from the program's revenue of the scholarship recipient.

- 5.2 The Faculty of Graduate Studies will deduct the program's revenue of the scholarship recipient for Research fee and/or equipment fee and Worksite Study fee (if applicable).
- 5.3 The scholarship recipient shall be responsible for paying any tuition fees incurred during the summer session in accordance with the Graduate School's schedule.
- 5.4 The Faculty of Graduate Studies will provide a living allowance to the scholarship recipient throughout the scholarship period or until the recipient has successfully passed the thesis examination, whichever comes first.

6. Application Selection and Evaluation Process

6.1 Program Quota Type

Students must submit their intention to the program they are enrolled in (refer to the list of programs in the appendix) for consideration by the Program Administrative Committee. The committee will then forward the names of those who meet the qualifications outlined in Section 3 to the Graduate School according to the following schedule:

6.2 Central Quota Type

Students must submit their intention to the program they are enrolled in, as specified in Section 3.1, for the program's consideration. The program will then propose the list of eligible candidates to the Graduate School for further review according to the following schedule:

7. Application for Scholarship and Submission of Eligible Scholarship Recipients

7.1 Students must contact the program directly, which will handle the application process and select eligible scholarship recipients.

7.2 Each program must submit the list of eligible scholarship recipients to the Faculty of Graduate Studies according to the schedule above, based on the allocated number as per the attached documents. If the submission deadline is missed, the Graduate School will not consider the application.

7.3 In the event that there are remaining scholarships from the program quota, the Graduate School reserves the right to reallocate these to students in the central quota type.

8. Documents Required for Scholarship Application

Applicants wishing to apply for the scholarship must use the application form prescribed by the Graduate School, Mahidol University, and submit the following documents:

- A copy of the passport
- A copy of the academic transcript
- A copy of degree certificate
- English language proficiency test results, as specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies
- Published works in recognized academic journals indexed in international databases (as per the scholarship type), with the applicant's name highlighted and the Quartile and Impact Factor information included on the first page of the publication.

9. Scholarship Conditions

9.1 The Graduate School will require scholarship recipients to sign a scholarship agreement and will begin the scholarship disbursement for students in either the first or second semester of the 2025 academic year.

9.2 Scholarship recipients must participate in the following activities:

- Scholarship award ceremony
- At least 2 additional activities as specified by the Graduate School during the scholarship period

9.3 Recipients of central quota scholarships at the doctoral level must publish and disseminate a Review Article within 2 academic years from the year they receive the scholarship.

10. Termination of Scholarship

- 10.1 Expiration of the scholarship period
- 10.2 The scholarship recipient voluntarily forfeits their scholarship
- 10.3 The scholarship recipient discontinues their studies, withdraws, or takes a leave of absence without valid reasons
- 10.4 The scholarship recipient engages in misconduct or violates the regulations and discipline of Mahidol University and/or the program/department they are enrolled in
- 10.5 The Chairperson of the Program Administration Committee recommends the suspension of the scholarship
 - 10.6 The scholarship recipient's academic performance falls below the required criteria:
 - For doctoral students: The cumulative GPA must be no lower than 3.50
 - For master's students: The cumulative GPA must be no lower than 3.25
 - 10.7 The evaluation results for any registered courses show a grade of C or U
- 10.8 The scholarship recipient for the central quota at the doctoral level fails to publish a Review Article within 2 academic years from the year the scholarship was awarded
- * If the student fails to comply with any of the conditions in 10.2 10.8, the student must repay the full scholarship amount to the Graduate School.

11. Implementation and Conditions

Any actions or conditions that cannot be carried out in accordance with this announcement shall be subject to the discretion of the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on a case-by-case basis.
