The position available is Researcher (9468) – 1 position, to be assigned to the Food and Nutrition Academic and Research Group (Food and Nutrition Database Unit). The details are as follows:

1. Position to be Filled

2. General and Specific Qualifications

Applicants must meet the general qualifications as per Mahidol University's Personnel Administration Regulations B.E. 2551 (2008) and possess the specific qualifications outlined in the appendix to this announcement.

3. Application Period, Submission Method, and Location

Interested applicants may submit their application documents via email at sunee.thn@mahidol.ac.th from now until April 30, 2025 (by 16:30 PM local time).

4. Required Application Documents

Applicants must submit the following documents along with their application:

- 4.1 1 passport-size photo (1-inch), taken from the front, without a hat or sunglasses.
- 4.2 A copy of the degree certificate or a certified document confirming completion of the academic program.
- 4.3 A copy of the academic transcript.
- 4.4 A copy of the household registration and national ID card.
- 4.5 A copy of additional documents (if applicable), such as a military conscription certificate, name change certificate, or marriage certificate.
- 4.6 A certificate of employment experience (if available).
- 4.7 A copy of an English proficiency test result.

Appendix to the Announcement (Dated March 26, 2025)

Position: Researcher (9468) – 1 Position

Qualifications (Job Specification):

1. A doctoral degree in one of the following fields: Data Science, Data Analytics and Data Science, Management of Analytics and Data Technologies Science, Information Technology Management, Computer Science and Information Systems, Bioinformatics and Computational Biology, Health Informatics, Bioinformatics, Statistics or Biostatistics
OR
2. A doctoral degree in Food and Nutrition Science, Dietetics, Nutrition, Biochemistry, or a related field with research experience in data science, database development, and management.
3. Candidates must demonstrate a strong command of English in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Applicants are required to submit proof of an English proficiency test taken within the past two years, meeting at least one of the following minimum scores:
 - IELTS (Academic Module): Overall score of 6 or higher
 - TOEFL iBT: Minimum score of 79
 - TOEFL ITP: Minimum score of 550
 - MU GRAD Test: Minimum score of 80
 - MU GRAD Plus: Minimum score of 90
 - CU-TEP: Minimum score of 75
 - TU-GET (Paper-Based): Minimum score of 550
 - TU-GET (Computer-Based): Minimum score of 80

Applicants who have graduated from a country where English is the official language are exempt from submitting proof of an English proficiency test.

2. Act as a research advisor for students' theses or assist in teaching courses.
3. Provide academic services.
4. Perform other assigned duties.
